

IT IS ALL ABOUT BEING HEALTHY: THE HEALTH MINISTRY TEAM

The SEAS health ministry team has the goal to raise awareness of the spiritual, interpersonal, emotional and physical health of our parishioners. The team works toward developing parish offerings and ministries that will enhance health at all levels of the parish.

The purpose of the parish nurse/health minister is to help the congregation care for one another. That means to help attain, maintain and/or regain the best possible whole person health – wellness of the body, mind and spirit that can be experienced. That spills over to all of us becoming a healthy faith community as well.

The team is open to anyone interested in health promotion.

What is the health team?

They are parish members who meet monthly to develop a plan of ministry for the health of the parish. It may be people who are or are not involved in health careers.

What is a parish nurse?

A parish nurse is a registered nurse who is certified in the specialty of parish nursing. They must meet the criteria developed by ANA for the safe practice of parish nursing. There are standards of care and practice that must be followed.

What is a certified health minister?

A certified health minister is someone interested in health ministry who has taken the parish nurse certification course.

What is a health ministry team member?

A health ministry team member is someone on the health ministry team who is interested in the ministry. This person does not have to be certified.
